



## Dover High School Winter Show

Welcome to all Directors, staff, students, and parents to Dover High School Winter Color Guard & Percussion Competition – a New England Scholastic Band Association (NESBA) sanctioned event.

We are excited to host this event again this year, but please be aware that we are in the new school, and therefore please take a moment to familiarize yourself with this information.

Warm-up and performance schedules, as well as a diagram of the competition and warm-up areas, will be handed out at the **check-in table**. Schedules can be found on the New England Scholastic Band Association (NESBA) web site. Directions are included in this packet and can also be found on the NESBA web site.

### Staff Passes

2018 NESBA Staff Badges will be honored; however additional staff members, chaperones, and helpers must pay \$10 Adult or \$8 Student for admission (no exceptions).

### Show Fees

Please be reminded that there is a **\$75** fee per performing group to participate in this event. Checks should be made out to **Dover Parents' Music Club**. Invoices will be mailed in advance and **can be found on the last page of this packet**.

### Bus and Truck Parking

**For spectators and staff**, parking will be in the front of the school.

**For buses**, performers will be dropped off on Alumni Drive near the check-in area first then buses will proceed to the Middle School for parking. Please note that there is no area for bus parking at the high school.

**For percussion and guard equipment vehicles**, loading/unloading will be in bus loop around the back of the new school. Trucks must be moved to the end of the bus loop after unloading.

### **Percussion – Performers Check-In - Check-Out**

The student/performer check-in area for percussion is located inside the Career Technical Center entrance in the front of the new High School. **All Percussion members are required to enter the school through this entrance.** Your \$75.00 participation fee will be collected at this entrance at which time all participating percussion members will be stamped for access after their performance. Any members who must assist with truck unloading will be guided to where percussion equipment will be loaded and unload. We will NOT be checking in performers or taking payment at the equipment entrance.

Due to limited space, upon your exit of the competition floor, all equipment must be removed from the building immediately via the front entrance. This exit will lead directly to the percussion equipment vehicle loading/unloading area.

### **Color Guard – Performers & Equipment Check-In - Check-Out**

The student/performer check-in area for percussion is located inside the Career Technical Center entrance in the front of the new High School. **All color guard members are required to enter the school through this entrance.** The check-in table is at this entrance where your \$75.00 participation fee will be collected and all participating guard members will be stamped for access after their performance.

Due to limited space, upon your exit of the competition floor, all equipment must be removed from the building immediately via the side entrance. This exit will lead directly to the equipment vehicle parking lot.

### **Dressing Rooms**

Bathrooms are available for performers to change and are located throughout the changing area halls. Groups will be assigned hallway spaces to get ready and “store” their things. Please be advised that neither Dover High School nor NESBA is responsible for lost or stolen property. We ask that one adult from each unit stay with your group while they are in the dressing areas.

### **Body and Equipment Warm-up Areas**

Please use only those areas designated for warm-ups. The schedule for your assigned areas and times will be handed to you at check-in.

**Percussion:** We have established 3 warm-up areas allowing for approx. 20 minutes per team depending on their class. Actual warm-up times and schedules will be handed out at check-in.

**Guard:** For body warm-up, we have established 2 warm-up areas allowing approx. 10 minutes per team. For equipment warm-up, we have established 2 warm-up areas in the practice gym allowing for approx. 10 minutes per team. Between body warm up and equipment warm-up there will be a 5-minute transition time. Warm-up and performance times will be posted throughout the facility.

Note: Please observe the times allocated for your team. Adequate transit time has been provided to avoid bottlenecks and all teams have been given the same warm-up minutes as the other teams in their class.

### **Parking**

Please obey all Fire, Loading, and Handicap Parking Areas. Violators will be towed at their own expense. You will be directed to your Bus and Equipment areas. Spectator parking will be posted and located in the front of the High school.

### **Awards**

Medals will be given for first, second, and third place in each division. Participation medals will be given in Festival class units. There will be two award presentations. One following the last percussion performance and one following the last guard performance.

### **Critique**

Percussion critique will start immediately following the last percussion performance and the Color guard critique will start immediately following the last guard performance. The Critique room is the Library which is located on the first floor (the main entrance floor).

### **General Information**

Concessions will be open from 10:45 A.M. with hot and cold items.

The show will be staffed with volunteers. Our volunteers are here to make your show experience a pleasant one. Do not hesitate to call on us if you have any problems or questions. If for some reason you feel that your needs are not being addressed, please ask the volunteer to have the event coordinators paged.

NESBA officials will be on-site for any questions concerning your performance. Competition Suite will be used to retrieve judges' comments.

## **Directions to Dover High School**

### **From the South**

1. Take I-95 N.
2. Merge onto RT-16 N/SPAULDING TURNPIKE via EXIT 4 on the LEFT toward US-4/NH LAKES/WHITE MTS (Portions toll).
3. Take the RT-108 exit, EXIT 7, toward DOVER/DURHAM.
4. Turn LEFT onto CENTRAL AVE/RT-108. Continue to follow RT-108.
5. Turn RIGHT onto ALUMNI DR. Guides will be there to direct you.

### **From the West**

1. Take 101 E towards Seacoast.
2. Take the RT-125 exit, EXIT 7, toward EPPING/KINGSTON.
3. Turn LEFT onto RT-125/CALEF HWY. Continue to follow RT-125 N.
4. Enter next roundabout and take the 1st exit onto US-4 E.
5. Take the RT-108 ramp toward DOVER/NEWMARKET.
6. Turn LEFT onto RT-108/DOVER RD. Continue to follow RT-108.
7. Turn LEFT onto ALUMNI DR.

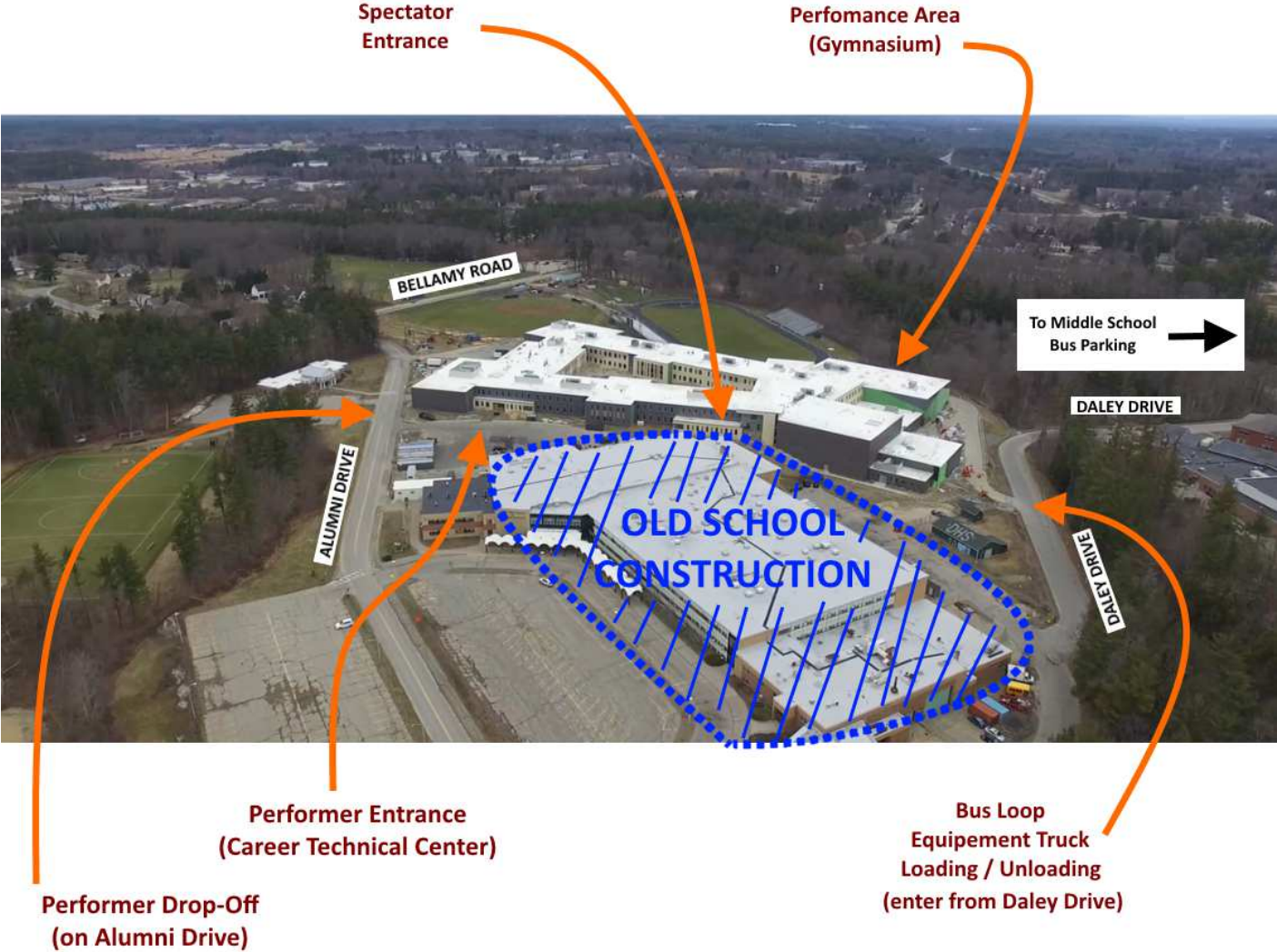
