Thank you for your participation in this year's NESBA show to be held at New Bedford High School's McCoy Field at 1:00pm on Sunday, October 2nd. Enclosed is a map of our facility, a warm-up schedule and an invoice for your group's show fee. Below are some notes that will assist you in performing at our facility:

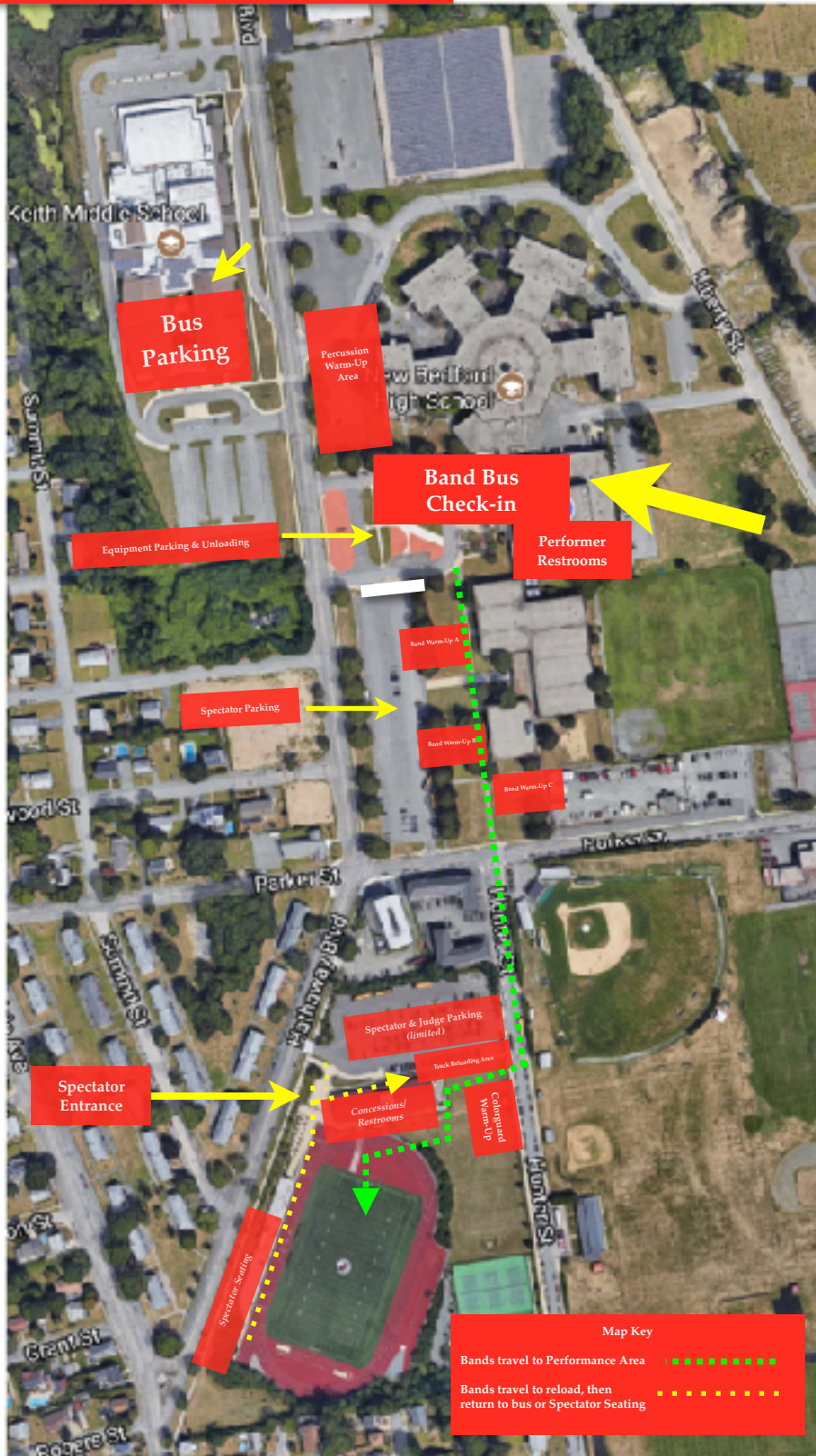
- All bands should bring their busses to the Band Bus Check-in area in the front of the school. Students will be stamped and a packet will be given to each Band Director.
- We suggest that performers use the restroom facilities that are available at the school building (Auditorium Entrance) before unloading their equipment. (Additional restroom facilities are located at the Stadium). Once students are unloaded, busses should park to the north side of the building.
- Truck and Equipment parking and unloading areas are located at the Southwest corner of the NBHS Building. (Please see the enclosed map.)
- In an effort to get everyone more warm-up areas, we have utilized more spaces around NBHS. Grassy areas to the South and West of the school building, will be reserved for warm-up as well as paved areas for percussion. Additionally, we have reserved a large grassy field to the East of the Stadium where Colorguard units can warm-up. There are no designated 'A', 'B', and 'C' Colorguard and Percussion spaces so please be respectful of other units and use only the space that you need.
- Bands should leave plenty of time to move to McCoy Field. Please note on the map where bands will enter into the McCoy Field facility through the Parking Lot off of Hunter St.
- It is recommended that spectators arrive well in advance of their band's performance time. There is limited parking on the street and in the lot nearest to the field area.

Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. - Form 1098 (home mortgage interest), 1098-E (student loan interest), 1098-T (tuition)
 - Form 1099-C (canceled debt)
 - Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)
