Welcome to all directors, staff, students, parents and guardians. We hope your day at Dartmouth is a success for all performing units, and we will work to make your experience as trouble free as possible.

- Performance times are on the NESBA website. Packets for warm-ups, changing areas, and other logistics will be at the registration table.
- **Show Fees:** Please be reminded that there is a \$100 fee per performing group to participate in this event. Checks payable to: D.S.M.A.
- **Entrance:** For spectators it is the main entrance next to the gym. For students and staff it is in the cafeteria just to the left of the main entrance. Large props may be unloaded at the gym.
- **Admission:** All students, staff, parents, and spectators need to be stamped or have a NESBA badge or ticket to enter the gym. Tickets are available at the main entrance. \$15.00/adults, \$10.00/students
- **Changing Areas:** Students may change in the boys and girls locker rooms. Any personal or group items is the sole responsibility of each performing group. Dartmouth and NESBA will not be responsible for articles left unattended. All groups are expected to clean up the locker room areas as they exit. Classrooms will not be used for changing. Lower hallway A will be used for groups to store their equipment. Please supply your own security. Dartmouth Schools will not be liable for anything taken.
- The **cafeteria** will be open throughout the show and will offer snacks, drinks, salads, sandwiches, chicken, burgers, fries, and more. Students and staff can eat before or after their performance. All food must stay in the cafeteria.
- **Awards:** Medals will be given for first, second, and third place in each division. Participation medals will be given in Festival Class units. There are two awards ceremonies, one following the color guard and one at the conclusion of the show for percussion.
- **Critique:** Color Guard critiques will start immediately following the last guard performance. Percussion critique will start immediately after the last percussion performance.

Thank you for your participation in the show at Dartmouth. During the event, please ask any of our student and parent volunteers for help or to answer any questions you may have. NESBA officials will be on-site for any questions concerning your performance. A digital tabulator will be on-site to issue and service MP3 players for the judge's comments.





- (G) TRACTOR AND BOX TRUCK PARKING ONLY
- (H) BUS PARKING
